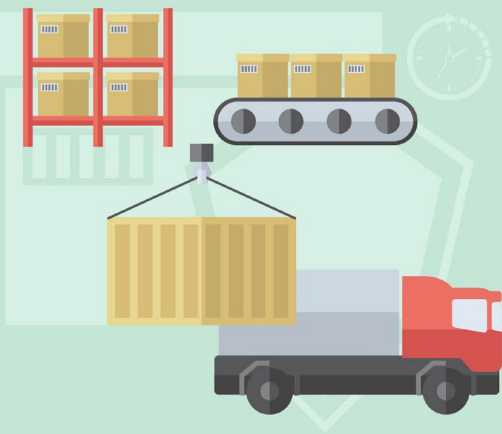


EXPORTING / IMPORTING OF PRODUCTS ARE NOT ALLOWED



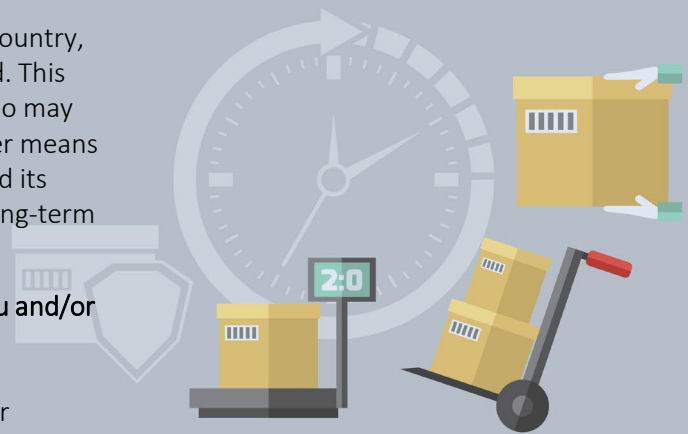
All Amway Business Owners (ABOs) have the opportunity to expand their businesses into countries where the Amway business has been established. Nevertheless, ABOs are prohibited from conducting any unauthorized activities in any country, regardless of whether or not Amway is doing business in that country.

Activities such as the importation/exportation of products and promotional materials without proper import licenses, registrations and labelling may subject the violating ABO(s) and Amway to substantial fines, confiscation of materials and product, etc.

The supply of Amway products from Singapore to any country, be it Malaysia, Brunei or any other country is prohibited. This includes supplying Amway products to a third party, who may redistribute or resell Amway products through any other means or channels. This is to protect the interest of Amway and its ABOs who share the same dreams like you, to build a long-term and sustainable business.

Please ensure that all Amway products purchased by you and/or your downline(s) are:

- Properly retailed to end users in Singapore;
- Not redistributed or resold in Singapore and/or other countries; and
- Sold at the price stipulated by Amway (Singapore) Pte Ltd



Why is exporting/importing or selling Amway products from Singapore to any other country or vice versa prohibited?

- To provide a fair business opportunity for all ABOs and to uphold fair trade in the business.
- The requirement for product registration to legally retain the product(s) in the country.
- Any unauthorized activities may undermine the reputation and goodwill associated with the Amway trademark and brand.



Can I ship, supply or retail Amway products purchased in Singapore to Malaysia and Brunei to ABOs who are operating in the same Line of Sponsorship?

- All ABOs can only order and supply Amway products in their own countries of operation.
- Retailing Amway products in other countries in which you are not authorized to conduct the business, whether directly or indirectly, constitutes a violation of Cross Border Activities (CBA) under the Amway Rules of Conduct as it jeopardizes the business of other ABOs in other countries.
